## OPERATING THE ARCHIVE SERIES CHRONOGRAPH

- To start chronograph timing, push button **A**.
- To stop chronograph timing, push button **A** again.
- To reset chronograph timing, push button **B**.  
All chronograph hands will return to zero position.

## READING THE ARCHIVE SERIES CHRONOGRAPH

For final chronograph time, simply read the times in order:

- 1** MINUTES (9 o'clock subdial)
- 2** 1/20th-seconds (3 o'clock subdial)
- 3** SECONDS (sweep second hand)
- 4** Regular second hand (or standard)



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
