## ARCHIVE SERIES CHRONOGRAPH A "SURFBOARD" COLLECTION

A style inspired by history, the Chronograph A is a nod to the popular styles from Bulova's diver chronographs from the 1970s. This style was popularly known as the "Surfboard" for the distinctive oval "surfboard" encircling the two sub dials

- This updated version features a stainless steel case with accents colors on and around the dial
- The dial features the notable oval around the sub dials
- · It features color-tipped hour and minute hands, luminous hands and markers, and chronograph second hand
- · Five-hand chronograph quartz movement, domed sapphire crystal with anti-reflective coating
- · Available in blue, black or orange perforated silicone strap with deployant closure
- Water resistance to 200 meters

#### SETTING THE TIME

This 2-subdial chronograph with built-in stopwatch can measure and display time up to 59 minutes/59 seconds and provide timing to 1/4 of a second.

- Unscrew the crown and then pull it out to the 2nd position, ©.
- Turn the crown clockwise to set hour and minute hands.
- Push crown back in and then screw back into case to the Normal Crown Position, A, to ensure optimal 200M Water resistance.

## READING THE ARCHIVE SERIES CHRONOGRAPH A

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## USING THE CHRONOGRAPH

This chronograph is able to measure and display time in 1/4 second united up to maximum of 59 minutes 59 seconds.

## Measuring time with the stopwatch

- 1. Press button "2" to start the chronograph.
- 2. The chronograph can be started and stopped each time button "A" is pressed.
- 3. Press button "4" to reset the chronograph and chronograph minute and second hands return to their zero positions.

## CHRONOGRAPH RESET (INCLUDE AFTER REPLACING BATTERY)

This procedure should be performed when the chronograph second hand does not return to the zero position.

- 1. Pull the crown out to the 2nd position, C
- 2. Press the button "2" once to set the chronograph second hand to the zero position.
  - \* The chronograph hand can be advanced rapidly by continuously pressing button "2".
- 3. Once the hands are set at zero position, reset the time and return the crown to its Normal Crown Position, (A)
