ARCHIVE SERIES CHRONOGRAPH A "SURFBOARD" COLLECTION

A style inspired by history, the Limited-Edition Chronograph A is a nod to the popular Bulova diver chronographs from the 1970s that were nicknamed the "Surfboard" for the distinctive blue oval shape encircling the two sub dials.

- This updated version features a stainless-steel case with blue and red accents and an off-white dial
- The notable blue surfboard oval, orange-tipped hour and minute hands, luminous hands and markers, and an orange chronograph second hand
- It features a Swiss 27-jewel five-hand automatic movement, 62-hour power reserve, domed sapphire crystal with anti-reflective coating, and a stainless-steel bracelet with deployment closure
- Limited to 350 pieces
- Swiss made
- Water resistant to 200 meters

SETTING THE TIME

This 2-subdial chronograph measures time up to 29 minutes/59 seconds.

- Unscrew the crown and then pull it out to the 2nd position, B.
- Turn the crown to set hour and minute hands.
- Push crown back in and then screw back into case to the Normal Crown Position, A, to ensure optimal 200M Water resistance.
- The movement can be manually wound with crown in Normal Crown Position, (A), the crown will need to be unscrewed.

OPERATING THE CHRONOGRAPH:

- Press Chronograph start / stop pusher 2 to start and to stop chronograph timing.
- Press Chronograph reset pusher 4 to reset the chronograph to zero.
